Science & Nature *With Joann Healy*

- *A walking field trip to the Bartlett Mall to do some pond scouting, make fairy houses and learn about local plants and animals
- * A trip to the Kelley School garden to research butterflies and birds
- * An investigation of the Waterfront Park area to learn about the Merrimack River
- * Daily nature activities including outdoor exploration, interpretive nature displays, crafts and lively games

If the weather is too hot or rainy to head outside, we'll substitute a variety of fun indoor science experiments and environmental education activities.
